

Tinytapps Software Pvt Ltd, a company incorporated in Pune, MH, India (Registration no. 157075) and located at Office no.3, B/3 Kumar Cerebrum, Kalyaninagar, Pune, MH, India 411014 ("Tinytapps", "us" or "we") respects the privacy of the visitors to its Website located at <http://www.Tinytapps.com> or <http://www.weetablet.com> ("Website"), and users of its Services. This Privacy Policy informs you of our policies and practices regarding the collection, use, storage and disclosure of any Personal Information and Anonymous Information you submit to us through our Website or Services. Unless otherwise defined herein, capitalized terms shall have the meanings assigned to such terms set forth in the Tinytapps Terms and Conditions that you can find at [Terms and Conditions](#) and which incorporate this Privacy Policy by reference.

"Personal Information" is any information that allows us (or others) to identify an individual person and would include (for example) your name, address, email address, IP Address or phone number, as well as other non-public information that is associated with or directly linked to such information.

An "Internet protocol address" or "IP Address" is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer when you use the Internet. In some cases your IP Address stays the same from browser session to browser session; but if you use a consumer Internet access provider, your IP Address probably varies from session to session. We track IP Addresses solely in conjunction with session Cookies to analyze our web page flow and to determine the appropriate language settings for you based on your region if you did not previously indicate. You can find out more about the Cookies [and other tracking technologies] that we use and the purposes for which we use them in the section below headed 'Cookies'.

"Anonymous Information" means information or a combination of information that does not relate to or identify individual persons.

We collect and use Personal Information and Anonymous Information as described in this Privacy Policy.

We respect your right to privacy and will only process Personal Information (including any sensitive personal data) you provide us in accordance with the Information Technology Act, 2000 (the Act) and any other applicable privacy laws. For the purposes of these laws, the data controller is [Tinytapps, Inc]

## User Consent

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. By accessing and using our Website and Services, you agree to be legally bound by the terms of this Privacy Policy. In addition, for certain activities on the Website, we may further confirm your consent by asking you to expressly consent to the collection, processing, storage and use of your Personal Information according to this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with the terms of this Privacy Policy, please refrain from using our Website or accessing our Services.

## International Transfers

**Your Personal Information will be transferred to be processed by Tinytapps, Pvt Ltd, [and other third party data processors] for the purposes identified in this Privacy Policy.**

**By accessing or using our Website or Services or otherwise providing Personal Information to us, you consent to the processing, transfer and storage of information in and to India [and the other countries identified] for these purposes. Please be aware that countries, which are located outside Indian Subcontinent, may not offer the same level of data protection as countries located in the Indian Subcontinent, although our collection, storage and use of your Personal Information will continue to be governed by this Privacy Policy.**

You may revoke your consent at any time by contacting Tinytapps (address below) or by deleting the Personal Information you have submitted through our Website or Services.

## Collection of Personal Information

The Personal Information we gather from you helps us learn about your visit to the Website or use of the Services. We use this information to provide the Services to you, to better tailor the features, performance and support of our products and services, to answer your requests, questions and concerns, and to offer you additional information and opportunities.

## Personal Information You Provide to Us

We collect Personal Information that you submit to us voluntarily through our Website or Services.

- When you register on the Website, we will collect your full name and username, a password, and an email address. We use these data to create your account and to provide the Services to you.
- When you use the Service, we collect your user ID, email address and IP address. We collect this information to better tailor the features, performance and support of our products and services.

- When you create your profile on the Website after registering, we will collect on an optional basis other Personal Information, such as information about your hobbies, interests, additional contact information, etc. You do not have to provide this additional information but if you do, we will use this information to better tailor the features, performance and support of our products and services.
- When you order products or services on the Website, we will collect all information necessary to complete the transaction, including your name, credit card information, billing information and shipping information.
- When you subscribe to a Tinytapps newsletter, we will collect your email address to provide you with promotional information about our services where you have agreed to receive such communications. You may unsubscribe from the newsletter service at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions provided in the newsletter you receive or by contacting us.
- When you contact us to submit comments, questions or feedback using the forms on the Website or in the Services, we will collect your name, email address and your comment, question or feedback to answer your request, questions or concerns.
- When you voluntarily participate in one of our surveys, we may collect additional profile information such as demographic information. We use this information to better tailor the features, performance and support of our products and services.
- When you register via the Wee tablet, we will collect your name and personal information, your child's name and date of birth or even your spouse's personal information to better tailor the features performance and support of our product and services.
- When you contact us using the request forms on the Website or in the Services, we will collect your name, email address and your comment or question that you enter into the form to answer your request, questions or concerns.
- When you post messages on the message boards of the Website or through the Services, the information contained in your posting will be stored on our servers and made public so other users will be able to see it.
- When you contact us by sending us an email, we will collect and store your email address and any information contained in the email you send us and any information attached to the email for so long as is necessary. This information is used to answer your email and address any questions and concerns you may have.

### **Personal Information Collected Via Tracking Technology**

As you navigate our Website or App, certain information may also be passively collected, including your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, operating system, mouse clicks, mouse movements, scrolling activity. We also use Cookies and navigational data like Uniform Resource Locators (URL) to gather information regarding the date and time of your visit and the solutions and information for which you searched and which you viewed. This type of information is collected to analyze the use of our Services and solutions and to make them more useful to you. Like other aspects of our Services, we use a third party service provider for some or all of this type of data collection and analysis. These third party service providers may also independently collect information about you as described in "Disclosure of Personal Information" below. For more detailed information about Cookies and other online tracking tools that we use and the purposes for which we use them, please see our section below headed "Cookies".

### **Personal Information We Receive From Other Sources**

We may receive Personal Information about you from other sources like mobile device, telephone or fax or from companies that provide our services by way of a co-branded or private-labeled website ("Partner Companies"), and for some of our Services, this includes location based services applicable for certain features in the Services. If you choose to disable location based services some features of the Services may not work properly. We may add this information to the information we have already collected from you via our Website or Services in order to improve the products and services we provide.

### **Use of Information**

In general, Personal Information you submit to us is used either to respond to requests that you make, or to aid us in serving you better. We may also use your Personal Information to, provide you with the Tinytapps newsletters, surveys, or promotional emails regarding changes and upgrades to our products and services and for other marketing purposes of Tinytapps or our partners, should you request and consent to receive such communications from us. For more information about how to change your preferences and to unsubscribe from promotional communications, please see the section below headed "Your Choices Regarding Your Personal Information".

We may create Anonymous Information records from Personal Information by excluding information (such as your name) that makes the information personally identifiable to you. We may use this Anonymous Information to analyze request patterns and usage patterns so that we may enhance our products and services. We may disclose this Anonymous Information to third parties contracted by Tinytapps to provide marketing services designed to promote

our products and services. Tinytapps reserves the right to use and disclose Anonymous Information to third parties in its discretion.

## **Feedback**

If you provide feedback on any of our products and services to us, we may use such feedback for any purpose, provided we will not associate such feedback with your Personal Information. Tinytapps will collect any information contained in such communication and will treat the Personal Information in such communication in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

## **Disclosure of Personal Information**

Except as otherwise stated in this Privacy Policy, we do not trade, rent, or share your Personal Information with third parties and we will not disclose financial information that is part of your Personal Information unless you ask us to do so.

We may share your Personal Information with third parties to provide you with the products and services that we offer you through the Website or Services. These third parties are required not to use your Personal Information other than to provide the products and services requested by Tinytapps and are bound by confidentiality agreements with regard to their use of such information. You expressly consent to the sharing of your Personal Information with our contractors and third party service providers for the sole purpose of providing products and services to you.

We may enter into co-branding or co-promotional agreements with third parties pursuant to which we may share Personal Information with such third parties. For example, we may enter into agreements with Partner Companies pursuant to which we provide the Partner Companies with a URL and a customer registration page co-branded with, or private labeled by, the Partner Companies, and the Partner Companies distributes and promotes the URL to its customers. A Partner Company may have access to Personal Information that we collect from their customers. As a result, if you register on the Website or use our Services through a Partner Company, we may provide your Personal Information to the Partner Company. Please note, however, that we do not control the privacy practices of these third parties.

If another company acquires our company or our assets, that company will possess the Personal Information collected by us and it will assume the rights and obligations regarding your Personal Information as described in this Privacy Policy.

Regardless of any choices you make regarding your Personal Information (as described below), we may disclose your Personal Information if we believe in good faith that such disclosure is necessary to (a) comply with relevant laws or to respond to subpoenas or warrants served on Tinytapps; or (b) to protect and defend the rights or property of Tinytapps or users of our Services.

## **Your Privacy Rights**

You have the right to access information held about you. Any access request may be subject to a fee of INR 500 to meet our costs in providing you with details of the information we hold about you. You also have the right to ask us to update and correct any out-of-date or incorrect personally identifiable information that we hold about you free of charge.

## **Cookies**

We may use Cookies to collect information about you.

### ***What is a cookie?***

“Cookies” are small pieces of information that a web site sends to your computer’s hard drive while you are viewing a web site. For example, we may use both session Cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience on the Website or Services. Persistent Cookies can be removed by following Internet browser help file directions. If you choose to disable Cookies, some areas of the Website or Services may not work properly. We encode our Cookies so that only we can interpret the information stored in them. For more information about removing or rejecting Cookies, please see “Your Choices Regarding Your Personal Information “below.

Tinytapps may also collect information via clear gifs or web beacons (also known as "tracking pixels") that help us better manage content on Website and Services by informing us what content is effective. Clear gifs are tiny graphics with a unique identifier, similar in function to Cookies, and are used to track the online movements of Web users. In contrast to Cookies, which are stored on a user's computer hard drive, clear gifs are embedded invisibly on Web pages.

### ***How do we use cookies?***

Cookies do lots of different jobs on our Website, such as letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, remembering your email and password, letting us analyze how well our Website is performing, and

improving your experience. [They also help ensure that adverts you see whilst you are on our Website are more relevant to you and your interests]

#### ***What cookies do we use?***

Below we have provided a list of the categories of Cookies found on our Website, and a description of what those Cookies do. Some of these Cookies are essential to the operation of our Services. Others are not essential, but help to improve our Website by collecting [anonymous] user information, or try and improve your experience of our Website by remembering your choices. We also use cookies, which collect information about your browsing habits in order to try, and display advertising, which is relevant to you and your interests.

We use the following types of Cookies:

**Strictly Necessary Cookies** We use a number of Cookies, which are essential to the operation of our Website and Services. We use other Cookies to help recognize and remember you when you are logged into our Services so we can remember your settings and preferences, such as your language and region or logged in state. These Cookies also may help us provide services you have asked for.

As described below, you may disable any of these functional Cookies; but if you do so, then various functions of the Services may be unavailable to you or may not work the way you want them to.

In case IP-anonymization is activated on this website, your IP Address will be truncated within the area of Member States of the European Union or other parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases the whole IP Address will be first transferred to a Google server in the USA and truncated there. The IP-anonymization is active on this Website.

#### **Your Choices Regarding Your Personal Information**

We offer you the following choices regarding the collection, storage, use, and sharing of your Personal Information:

- Mozilla Firefox

  - Select the privacy tab in the options box.
  - From the dropdown choose, 'use custom settings for history'. This will bring up the options for cookies and you can choose to enable or disable them by clicking the tickbox.
- Internet Explorer 6+
  - In the tools menu, select 'Internet options'.
  - Click the privacy tab.
  - You will see a privacy settings slider which has six settings that allow you to control the number of cookies that will be placed: Block All Cookies, High, Medium High, Medium (default level), Low, and Accept All Cookies.
- Safari browser
  - In the settings menu / Safari menu, select the 'preferences' option.
  - Open the privacy tab.
  - Select the option you want from the 'block cookies' section.
- All other browsers
  - For information on how to manage cookies via other browsers, please consult your documentation or online help files.

Please note that if you choose to remove or reject Cookies, this could affect the availability and functionality of the Services. Tinytapps has implemented industry-standard electronic means of protecting your Personal Information. We store Personal Information behind a computer firewall, a barrier designed to prevent outsiders from accessing our servers, and we have implemented technology to detect intrusions. We also require you to enter a password to access your account information. In addition, Tinytapps protects your Personal Information from unauthorized physical access by storing your Personal Information in a controlled facility.

Except as provided elsewhere in this Privacy Policy, Tinytapps limits access to Personal Information in electronic databases to those persons (including employees and contractors) in Tinytapps's organization who have a business need for such access. Lastly, we conduct periodic internal audits and vulnerability scans to ensure compliance with these security measures and generate security incident logs that track Information useful in screening for attempted abuse of or unauthorized access to your Personal Information.
